### Giving back to those who served.

#### **Veteran Homelessness**

Most Veterans appreciate being thanked for their service, but for homeless veterans "thank you" is not enough. Those who served our country are sleeping on the streets and under bridges- and a percentage are chronically homeless. Others have been devastated by returning home to a recession and lack of employment, and some have struggled with post-traumatic stress disorder and addictions fueled by memories of the horrors of war.

#### **Project H3 VETS**

The good news is there is something we can do to help. The Franciscan Renewal Center's Outreach to Veterans and Military Families ministry is assisting the Arizona Coalition to End Homelessness-Project H3 VETS by supplying veterans with needed items on the day they are given the keys to their new home. It has been found that the "Housing First" model not only gives veteran a sense of dignity, but also gives them the resources to heal physically and spiritually.

Furthermore, it is cost effective for the State of Arizona to have a veteran living in his or her own home compared to living in a shelter.

#### How to get involved

What can you do? That's the easy part. You can donate money or NEW household items to help build a move-in basket. The cost is around \$140 to stock an entire apartment with items for the kitchen, bathroom, bedroom and laundry room by shopping at discount stores. Your contributions are tax deductible.


