Dear Holy People of God,
We are entering The Jubilee Year of Hope. It invites us to reimagine the meaning of restoration and renewal through the lens of God's steadfast love and transformative power. The first reading this Sunday paints a vivid picture of God's commitment

to His people: "For Zion's sake I will not keep silent, for Jerusalem's sake I will not remain quiet, till her righteousness shines out like the dawn, her salvation like a blazing torch."

We often associate black with grief and sorrow. It is the color worn at funerals, signaling loss and finality. But with the spiritual symbolism, black is the color of *hope*. Psalm 130 captures this truth beautifully: "Like a watchman wait for the morning, let Israel hope in the Lord." A watchman sits in the deep blackness of the night, waiting expectantly for dawn to break. The blackness of night, though heavy and obscure, carries within it the promise of light. Similarly, in life's darkest seasons, hope begins to stir.

When I created an icon of a saint, starting with a black background. The face, at first veiled in shadow, slowly came to life as I added colors, tones, and highlights. This process became a powerful symbol of hope. From the black—the seeming void—emerged beauty, depth, and radiance. The black was not erased but transformed, becoming the foundation for something luminous.

Let us, therefore, embrace the "black" moments of life with *hope*. Let them remind us of the dawn that always follows night and our God who is tirelessly working to make all things new.

Let us hope in our God!

Welcome to the peaceful, nurturing space of Ordinary Time ...

Today is the second Sunday in Ordinary Time! "Ordinary Time" refers to the numbered weeks of the year, and while it's not a season like Advent or Lent, it has a rhythm of its own. It typically lasts 33 or 34 weeks, depending on when Easter falls and any special feast days that might fall on Sundays. This time of year includes the days between the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and Ash Wednesday, and right after the Baptism of the Lord, we begin the First Week in Ordinary Time, making today the Second Sunday.

The flow of the liturgical seasons mirrors the rhythm of life — a mix of celebrations and quieter seasons of growth. To deepen our spiritual lives and grow in faith, we need to step away from the peaks of Christmas and Easter and spend time in the peaceful, nurturing space of Ordinary Time.

Prayer on the Occasion of the Inauguration

This prayer, from the U.S. edition of the Book of Blessings (no. 1965), is an adaptation of the prayer for the Church and for civil authorities which was composed by Archbishop John Carroll for use on the occasion of the inauguration of George Washington in 1789.

*Almighty and eternal God,
you have revealed your glory to all nations.
God of power and might, wisdom and justice,
through you authority is rightly administered,
laws are enacted, and judgment is decreed.*

*Assist with your spirit of counsel and fortitude
the President of these United States,
that his administration may be conducted in righteousness,
and be eminently useful to your people over whom he presides.
May he encourage due respect for virtue and religion.
May he execute the laws with justice and mercy.
May he seek to restrain crime, vice, and immorality.*

*Let the light of your divine wisdom
direct the deliberations of Congress,
and shine forth in all the proceedings and laws framed
for our rule and government.
May they seek to preserve peace, promote national happiness,
and continue to bring us the blessings of liberty and equality.*

*We pray for the governor of this state,
for the members of the legislature,
for judges, elected civil officials,
and all others who are entrusted to guard our political welfare.
May they be enabled, by your powerful protection,
to discharge their duties with honesty and ability.*

*We likewise commend to your unbounded mercy
all citizens of the United States,
that we be blessed in the knowledge and sanctified in the
observance of your holy law.
May we be preserved in union and that peace which the
world cannot give;
and, after enjoying the blessings of this life,
be admitted to those which are eternal.*

*We pray to you, who are Lord and God,
for ever and ever. Amen.*
