PASTORAL REFLECTION



In Luke's Gospel, noteworthy moments occur after the nets overflow. Peter realizes his unworthiness and recognizes the presence of the Messiah, and this group of laborers/fishermen drop everything and follow Jesus. Undoubtedly significant.

And yet, I wonder if the moments before have an equal impact.

After a long night of fishing with no results, Peter and his partners are washing their nets, exhausted, vulnerable, and disappointed. Along walks Jesus who commandeers their boats so he can teach the crowds. And then he tells them to move to and cast their nets in the deeper waters. Peter responds with, "We have worked hard all night and... nothing."

I can relate to striving, working, and struggling with meager results and the accompanying feelings of uncertainty, self-doubt, and the temptation to flee. But Peter does not turn away and says, OK, if you say so, I'll do it. This action, this moment, transforms his life, and ultimately, in following Jesus, changes the world.

When we least expect it, God asks us, invites us, to trust and do. And we have a choice. To see or not, to react or not, to be open or not. How we respond to these encounters with God is a lifelong process. We too can say, "OK, if you say so, I'll do it," and go out to the deep water in the middle of the day and see what happens. We can take the risk and be part of the story that continues Jesus' ministry and brings hope to the world.

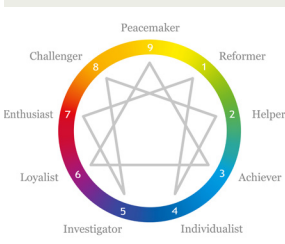

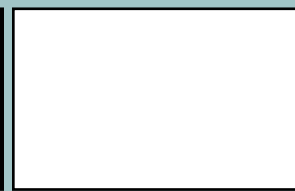
