PASTORAL REFLECTION



Fifteen years ago, I gave birth to Maximilian. I cried, smiled, laughed, and thought, "I can't believe God loves and trusts me so much." His love is all-consuming, a love that knows no bounds, some would say unconditional, and I do

my best to love him back in the same way.

This has contributed to a better understanding of the Incarnation from a Franciscan perspective. When God, in all His divine glory, chose to become human, to experience the joys and sorrows of earthly life, it was an act of love beyond comprehension. He understood the human condition, He knew the weight of our burdens and loved us enough to share in our experiences. He chose to be in communion with us and showed us His love.

1 Thessalonians 3:12 says, "May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you." 
