PASTORAL REFLECTION

The Christmas season has begun and before we even blink our eyes, Holy Family Sunday has arrived. For the Gospel on this day, our Church has chosen a story outside of Luke's infancy narrative that involves the members of the Holy Family: Jesus, Mary, and Joseph.

But when we listen to this story carefully, it becomes clear that it is a foreshadowing of the Passion, Resurrection, and Ascension and thus unclear why we would proclaim it during the Christmas season. Let's sum up the story this way: The time is Passover. Jesus goes to Jerusalem. But when the Passover is over, Jesus is missing. He is gone for three days. After three days, he shows up. Those who are closest to him cannot understand why he would leave them like that. Jesus responds to them by asking, "Why were you looking for me? Didn't you know where I must be?" Let's remember that Luke's community (which probably would have been Antioch) was trying to come to grips with the fact that Jesus' return was not as imminent as the previous generation thought. What were they to do if the Jesus of the past was gone and the Jesus of the future wasn't coming back any time soon?

Well, the story of Jesus the boy in the Temple is a reminder to Luke's community and to us today that the Jesus of *now* lives on through the community of believers. If Jesus appears to be missing in our lives, it is most likely because we have forgotten where Jesus must be. We are the Holy Family of today, and Jesus the Risen Lord must be born and living in us. Like Mary, we would do well to "keep all these things" in our hearts.

In the spirit of hope, the St. Paul addressed these words of encouragement to the Christians of Rome. Hope is also the central message of this coming Jubilee Year.

Even so, uncertainty about the future may give rise to conflicting feelings, ranging from confident trust to apprehensiveness, from serenity to anxiety, from firm conviction to hesitation and doubt.

Often we come across people who are discouraged, pessimistic and cynical about the future, as if nothing could possibly bring them happiness. For all of us, may the Jubilee be an opportunity to be renewed in hope. God's word helps us find reasons for that hope. Taking it as our guide, let us return to the message that the Apostle Paul wished to communicate to the Christians of Rome.

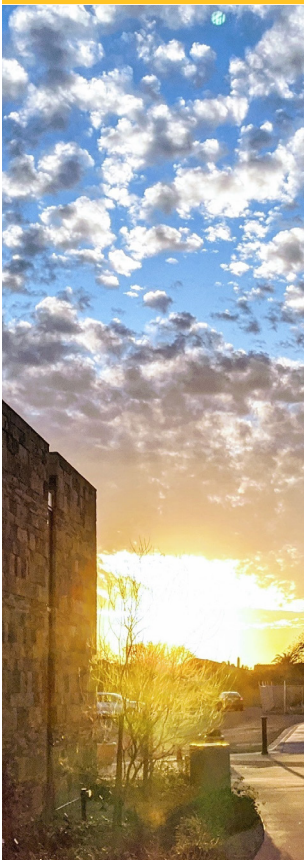
January 11–12: Support the St. Charles Apache Mission School

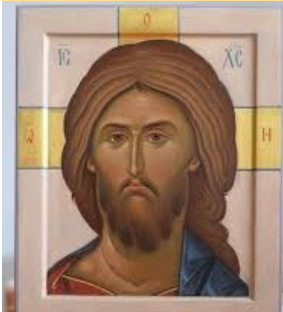



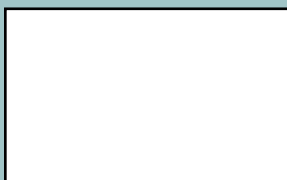
