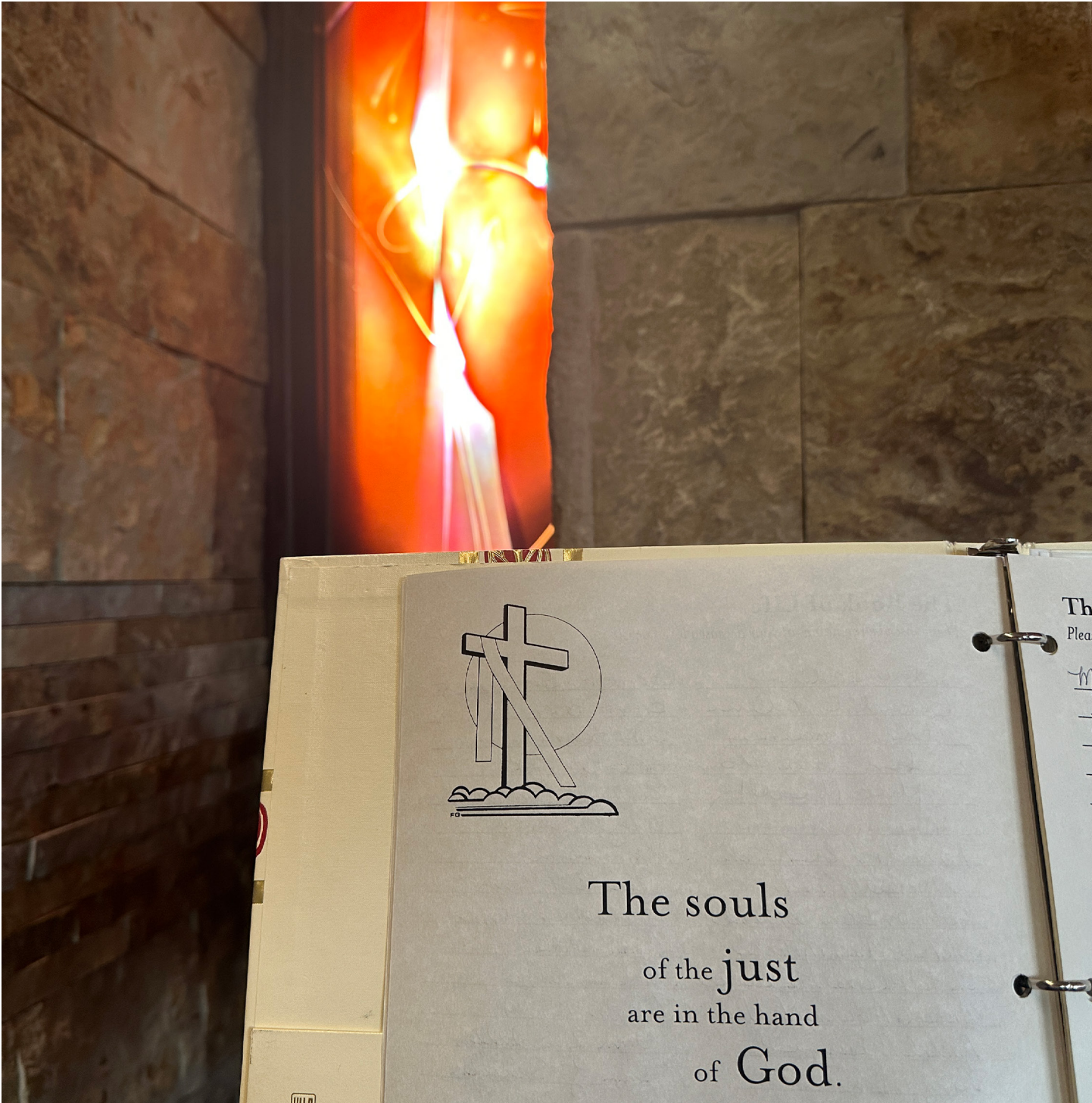

PASTORAL REFLECTION



We are at the end of the liturgical year again with the Gospel's colorful description of the end times. Jesus reminds us that all things must come to an end, including our own lives. Death is extremely difficult to face, either our own or that of our loved ones. Confronting our own mortality is a scary endeavor.

Several years ago, I discovered the spiritual practice of Memento Mori. It is a Latin phrase which means "remember you must die." Essentially, it is about living a life of meaning, purpose, and gratitude within the context of the limited time we have been given here on earth. It is about dying to our false self and unhealthy attachments. Since then, it has shaped the way that I view each precious day that I get to better myself and spend meaningful time with others. It has also given me a sense of joyful expectation of what we will experience and who we will again be with after death. Even St. Francis recognized this and welcomed Sister Death!

As I prepared for this reflection, I was reminded of one of my favorite scenes from Lord of the Rings. I leave you with wise words from Gandalf the White. "PIPPIN: I didn't think it would end this way. GANDALF: End? No, the journey doesn't end here. Death is just another path, one that we all must take. The grey rain-curtain of this world rolls back, and all turns to silver glass, and then you see it. PIPPIN: What? Gandalf? See what? GANDALF: White shores, and beyond, a far green country under a swift sunrise. PIPPIN: Well, that isn't so bad. GANDALF: No. No, it isn't." — J.R.R. Tolkien, The Lord of the Rings

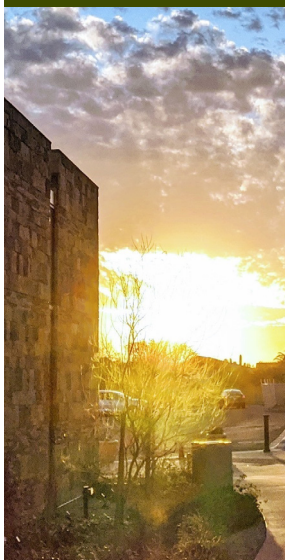

I love walking the Casa grounds. Depending on the month, you can hear the sound of woodpeckers hammering into trees. My favorite, the hummingbirds. Hummingbirds fly in all directions and at times, hover. When plant diving their wings beat 200 times per second. Hummingbirds are known to fly alone for 500 miles. Very hard working, always contributing, at times not easy to spot when pollenating. As a result, the Casa has a range of colorful blooms.

Hummingbirds tend to remind me of the Casa volunteers who at times travel a great distance, bringing a diverse range of interesting talent and skills, with the shared goal of supporting the Franciscan Renewal Center. 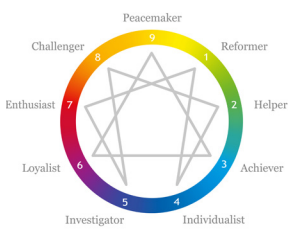



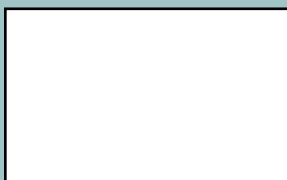
