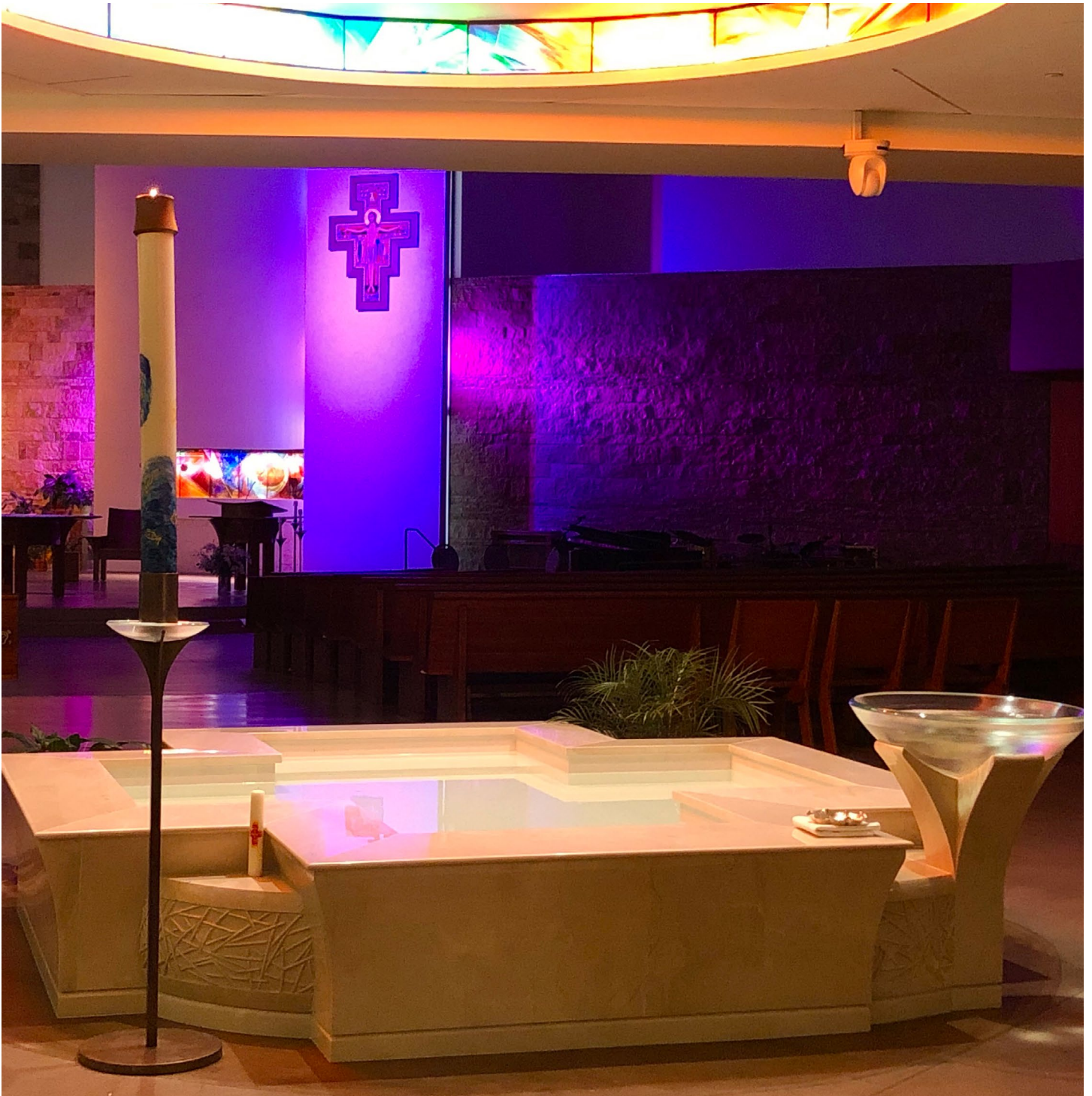

PASTORAL REFLECTION



This weekend the Church celebrates and honors The Most Holy Trinity. The truth of the Holy Trinity has been at the very root of the Church's living faith (Paragraph Number 249 Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC)) primarily by means of Baptism.

One is baptized "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." (CCC #232) When we make or renew our Baptismal Promises, we say we believe in God, in Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit. The faith of all Christians rests on the Trinity. There is only one God, the almighty Father, his only Son, and the Holy Spirit: The Most Holy Trinity (CCC # 233).

The Gospel (Mt. 28: 16-20) reminds us of Jesus' request: Go, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. He also promises that He will be with us until the end of the age. What a great promise!

In the Eucharist Prayer, we are reminded that: For with your Only Begotten Son and the Holy Spirit you are one God, one Lord; not in unity of a single person, but in a Trinity of one substance.

For what you have revealed to us of your glory we believe equally of your Son and of the Holy Spirit, so that, in the confessing of the true and eternal Godhead, you might be adored in what is proper to each Person, their unity in substance and their equality in majesty.

This mystery is foundational for our faith.

How blessed we are.

The Young Dead Soldiers

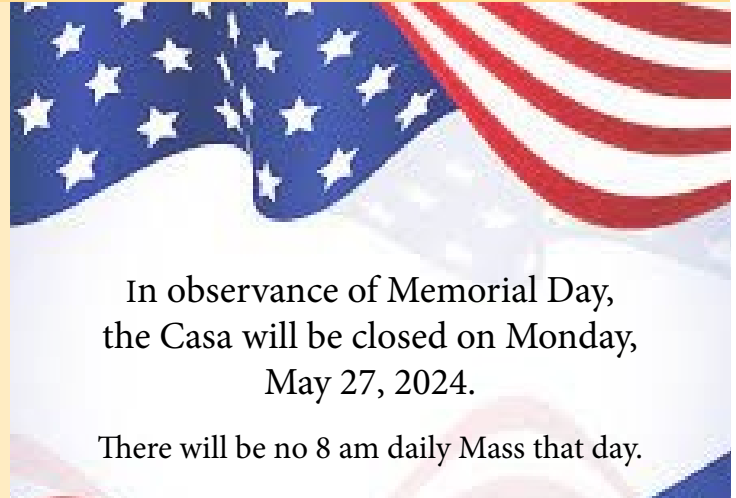
(by Archibald MacLeish, 1892–1982)
