Dear Holy People of God,
Moses said in the first reading this Sunday, "...What great nation is there that has gods so close to it as the Lord, our God, is to us whenever we call upon him?" This question invites us to reflect on our intimacy with God, especially through the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

In the Eucharist, we encounter the fullness of God's nearness, a divine intimacy that surpasses even the closeness described in Deuteronomy. Here, God does not just draw near to us; He becomes one with us. In this Sacrament, Jesus, the Son of God, comes to us under the appearance of bread and wine, not merely as a symbol but as His actual Body and Blood. This mystery of faith allows us to experience God's presence in a way that is both tangible and transformative.

The Eucharist is the gift that surpasses the experiences of ancient Israel. As they marveled at God's proximity in the temple and in His mighty deeds, we are invited to marvel at His humble yet profound presence in the Eucharist. Here, the Almighty God comes to us in the simplest of forms, allowing us to receive Him physically, to be united with Him in a deeply personal and intimate way.

We are all invited to experience the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist during Holy Mass and also in Eucharistic Adoration, which our Church holds every First Friday of the month at 6 pm. Come!

QUARANTA GIORNI SUL MONTE LA VERNA

FORTY DAYS ON MOUNT LA VERNA

Two performances

Saturday, September 28, 2024 • 7 pm

Sunday, September 29, 2024 • 2 pm

800 years ago this month, St. Francis of Assisi spent forty days in a retreat of intense prayer and fasting on a remote and rugged Italian mountain called La Verna. During an afternoon of quiet prayer and meditation, Francis had a mystical vision. In the time following that intense encounter, his companions began to notice marks on his hands, feet, and side that reminded them of the wounds of Jesus. In the remaining two years of his life, Francis never spoke of those marks and apparently tried to conceal them, not wanting to draw attention to himself. The musical performance “Quaranta Giorni” explores the events that led Francis to La Verna in the first place, and stories of what happened on the mountain, as well as what followed that transformative experience.

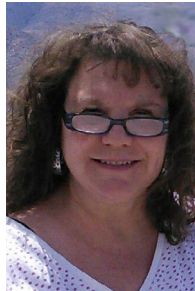

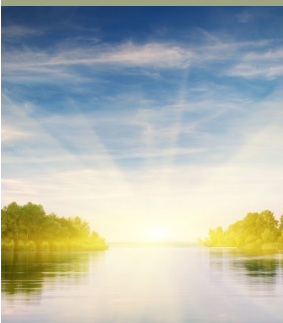

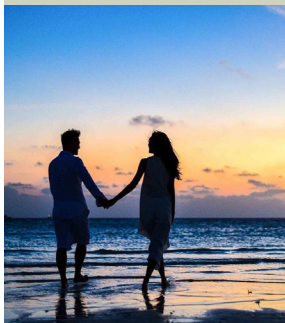
