

#### PASTORAL REFLECTION



"Go your way; your faith has saved you." In how many moments have we asked something of Jesus and felt a silence in reply? Especially within a society that teaches us from an early age to pursue success, we can stumble into the disillusionment of entitled prayer. Our pride fuels our desire to

receive everything precisely as we requested. In this entitlement, we lose presence and gratitude. We also forget that God's healing is rarely so straightforward.

I'm not suggesting that the miraculous is impossible. I have witnessed many miracles firsthand, and I believe the infinite expanse of Creation holds unexplainable beauty and wonder. I'm also in no way suggesting that prayers of petition are useless. They are important as spiritual anchors and can be incredibly aligned with God's will. Instead, I would suggest considering prayer as a form of open opportunity. It is in our openness that God can influence us, guide us, and show us what we need.

My Confirmation Saint, Juan de la Cruz, wrote a great deal about finding presence in what may at first seem like an absence. In Noche Oscura, he writes, "Que si un hombre desea estar seguro del camino que pisa debe cerrar los ojos en la oscuridad," which translates to "If anyone wishes to be sure of the road they tread on, they must close their eyes and walk in the dark." This is a challenging notion, and I struggle with it daily. It is imperative to remember, though, that deep struggles will invariably and profoundly strengthen our faith. Through our Franciscan Ministry of Presence, we can try (little by little) to make that strengthening a bit more peaceful.

In this way, finding the healing of Christ is as simple as closing our eyes.

## QUARANTA GIORNI SUL MONTE LA VERNA Forty Days on Mount La Verna

**800** years ago, St. Francis spent 40 days praying and fasting on a remote and rugged Italian mountain called La Verna. While deep in prayer and contemplation, he experienced an extraordinary mystical vision. Following that encounter, his companions began to notice marks on his hands, feet, and side resembling the wounds of Christ. The musical event QUARANTA GIORNI tells the story of what led Francis to La Verna in the first place, and the legends of what happened on the mountain, as well as what followed that transformative experience.

Curt Sather, a Wisconsin native, began music lessons at age 7 on accordion and organ. He holds degrees in Organ Performance from Arizona State University and the Eastman School of Music. He served 13 years at St. Barnabas on the Desert Episcopal Church in Scottsdale as Organist& Choirmaster and is currently Organist & Director of Music at Trinity Episcopal Church, Wauwatosa, WI. He spent four years in Florence, Italy, as organist at the historic Benedictine monastery of San Miniato al Monte, performing daily recitals, as well as serving as an organist in the Duomo (Cathedral) of Florence and St. Mark's Anglican Church. He has performed across the USA, Europe, New Zealand, and Australia, recorded several CDs, and taught numerous students. He has performed the complete organ works of J. S. Bach four times, including a 14-week recital series and a 24-hour marathon to celebrate Bach's birthday. Attendance is free to all!


