

#### PASTORAL REFLECTION



The top of the refrigerator. When I was a child, that's where my parents hid the baby Jesus from our nativity set in the weeks leading up to Christmas. Each year, we waited with barely contained excitement, knowing that on Christmas Eve, when the time finally came to open gifts, the little

figure would make its journey from its secret resting place to the manger. That was the moment we all knew: the time was now!

As a young child, I didn't learn where the baby Jesus was hidden until the year it fell behind the refrigerator and a piece of its arm chipped off. In my youthful innocence, I wondered how they could leave the baby alone up there, so high and precarious, in clear danger of falling! I still smile at the memory, recalling the simplicity and wonder of those early Christmases.

As a young college student, working as the music director in our parish, the pastor gave me a small nativity set he had brought back from Italy. It wasn't fragile or valuable in the way many gifts are, but it meant something much more important. It symbolized a shared bond between us, a connection that carried deeper meaning than its material worth. Forty-four years later, I still have that nativity set. Each December, with a sense of deep gratitude and sentimentality, I place it among the other holiday decorations in my home, honoring its significance.

This is the season for sharing stories—and these memories are so precious because they help keep those traditions alive, reminding us of the simple joys and the deep connections that shape our holidays. How do you feel when you set up your nativity each year now, after all this time?





### We Get More than We Give — A Conversation with Casa Volunteers

Recently, Rosemarie LeClercq and Stan Martin told me about how volunteering is a blessing. Rosemarie said, "You build a community, in whatever ministry you work in." She volunteers in at least eight different Casa ministries, plus other episodic Casa projects. Another of her blessings? "When I go out to the sick (as EM to the Sick and Homebound), it's seeing the joy in their faces."

Stan, the lead volunteer for the Casa Gardeners, mentioned another blessing of volunteering, "When you see people in the garden, you know they put in an effort to be here. They'll say the nicest things." Rosemarie also mentioned, "You get to see the preparation for the events that

happen here."

They both said that as volunteers, they represent All Are Welcome, and are sensitive that visitors can be grieving when they come to the Casa.

Stan told how he once asked a couple in the gardens, "Can I do anything for you?" They had brought flowers to honor their deceased son. The mother said, "Do you think it would be okay if I brought some nice, silk flowers? They would last longer." Stan assured her that it would be fine. And he decided to make sure the flowers stayed for as long as they looked good. "You go into a conversation one way and come away with something different," said Stan.
