

Public Mass Guidelines

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE DECIDING WHETHER RETURNING TO PUBLIC MASS IS RIGHT FOR YOU AT THIS TIME. FOLLOWING THESE GUIDELINES IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND PUBLIC MASS AT OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS CHURCH.

The General Dispensation releasing Catholics from their Sunday obligation remains in place, giving you the freedom to participate via livestream on our [YouTube Channel: theCasaFRC](#).

Should I come to Mass? Each person must make the decision of what is best for themselves and their family.

Stay home if: 1) You are feeling sick or have a fever. 2) You have a sick family member at home or have been recently exposed to someone who may be sick. 3) You are a primary caretaker of a vulnerable person. 4) You have been traveling or in large crowds. 5) You are at risk because of preexisting conditions or age.

Entering/Leaving the Church and Being Seated: When you arrive, please come to the main entrance, and ushers will help guide you inside. Ushers will also guide you when leaving the church.

- Wearing a Face Mask that covers your nose and mouth must be worn throughout the Mass.
- Physical Distancing of at least 6 feet is required.
- Using Hand Sanitizer (will be provided) is required.
- Limited Seating will be available on a first come, first served basis.
- Ushers will guide each person or family to their seat. No open seating.
- No printed materials will be available. Prayers will be shown on screen.

- Communion will be given in the hand.
- Lower/lift your mask briefly to place the Body of Christ in your mouth.
